Reflecting on the past year fills us with gratitude and pride. Your unwavering support allowed us to expand our mission into water safety and community outreach while maintaining our financial aid and scholarship programs. Because of your generosity, The John Apple Swim Fund is creating a broader impact in Lancaster County with the following programs:



**Rescue Ready:** A primary concern for our community over the past few years was the safe operation of summer pools, particularly for the Lancaster County Deptartment of Parks and Recreation. In collaboration with other organizations, the innovative 'Rescue Ready' program was introduced. This initiative aimed to train students from the School District of Lancaster, equipping them with the necessary skills for lifeguard pre-tests. To further support this endeavor, the Swim Fund joined forces by covering the lifeguard certification costs for successful pre-test candidates. The inaugural year proved to be a success, as it resulted in the certification of 11 new lifeguards, contributing significantly to the safe and efficient opening of the pool.

**Summer Swim Lessons:** Our commitment to water safety extended to introducing basic swimming skills to children. Partnering with the Lancaster REC, we incorporated swim lessons into their summer camp series, impacting over 500 children. The overwhelmingly positive feedback indicates that swim lesson days were a favorite for summer campers.

**Financial Aid:** Since 2018, our financial aid program has assisted families struggling to cover USA swimming dues while dealing with challenging circumstances such as family deaths or job losses. Our efforts have supported at least two families per year, alleviating financial burdens during unpredictable circumstances.

**Scholarships:** The scholarship program, our inaugural initiative, awards two \$1,500 scholarships annually to high school seniors excelling in academics, leadership, community involvement, and a demonstrated commitment to swimming. Over the years, we've had the privilege of awarding 20 scholarships to high-achieving student-athletes across the county.

Your involvement and support have made these programs possible. As we step into 2024, we are steadfast in our commitment to sustaining all four initiatives. Our future goals include expanding summer camp swim lessons and increasing the scholarship awards, ensuring a more profound impact on our community.

Our annual fundraiser, Apple's Swim a Bridge, remains a cornerstone of our efforts. While we love having people swim with us in-person at Woodridge, remote participation in your own pool is equally encouraged. Let's work together to achieve our financial goal for 2024 and continue positively influencing the lives of young swimmers.
